## We affirm that:

- Our parish leadership (Priest, Council) and staff (paid and volunteer) are trained on the provisions of the Directives
- We have ordered (and will maintain stock of) the necessary supplies required for implementation, including (but not limited to) masks, hand sanitizer, cleaning & sanitizing supplies
- We have placed the required signage at the entry points and any other necessary area
- We will abide by the social distancing guidelines in worship and other on-site activities
- We have marked the appropriate seating areas and aisles
- We will have no more than 25 persons occupying one area (inclusive of the priest, staff, and any volunteers)
- We commit to disinfecting the Church and restrooms on a frequent basis in preparation for services
- We have communicated to the faithful of the Parish by e-mail, letter, website or other
  means in advance of the relaxation of restrictions all guidelines for proper social
  distancing, behavior in Church, and liturgical practices in accordance with the
  requirements and guidelines established by the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America
  and/or the Metropolis of Pittsburgh.

We certify that these requirements are met and will continue to be met, and the Parish is ready to move to "Yellow Phase" status.
