Please be advised that the *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek* will be administered on **Monday**, June 22nd, from 1:15 p.m. to 4:15 p.m.

To qualify for the *Examination*, students must be in the eighth grade or higher and have successfully completed **three years** of studies in the Modern Greek language.

The Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek is "a locally developed foreign language examination" aligned to the **Checkpoint B** learning standards for LOTE (Languages Other Than English) as described in the **Syllabus:** Modern Languages for Communication of the New York State Education Department.

The *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek* may afford high school students, who pursue studies in the Modern Greek language for more than two years, the opportunity to earn <u>a Regents</u> <u>diploma with advanced designation</u> (NYCRR §100.5[b][7][v][c]). Awarding of credits for foreign language studies, however, is at the discretion of the public or private school principal.
