COMMUNICATION TASKS PART 1: SPEAKING

This booklet contains the communication tasks for **Part 1: Speaking** of the **2014 Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek.** The tasks have been selected from the *Sourcebook of Speaking Tasks for Part 1* provided by the New York State Education Department.

The Part 1 speaking tasks may be administered from the time they are received through the time of the written test. **They must be kept secure at all times.**

Directions for administering and rating the students' oral communication performance are contained in the *Teacher's Manual*, which is enclosed. **Please follow the instructions carefully.**

- 1. [Student initiates] I am your friend in Greece. You have tickets to a show, which you cannot attend. You start the conversation.
- 2. [Student initiates] I am your friend. After a long day at school, you want to get some exercise. We will talk about it. You start the conversation.
- 3. [Teacher initiates] I am your friend. We had planned to go for a hike today, but the weather does not look very nice. We will try to decide what to do. I will start the conversation.
- **4.** [Student initiates] I am your friend in Greece. You have just received some important news from home and want to share it with me. You start the conversation.
- 5. [Teacher initiates] I am your neighbor in Greece. There has been a power failure. You come to me because there is no electricity in your home. I will start the conversation.
- **6.** [Student initiates] I am the receptionist at a dentist's office in Greece. You are having a problem. You start the conversation.
- 7. [Student initiates] I am a teacher from Greece who is visiting your school. You are showing me your school building. You start the conversation.
- **8.** [Student initiates] I am your friend. We are taking a walk, and you get hungry. You start the conversation.

- [Teacher initiates] I am a sales clerk in a sports shop. You are looking for sports equipment. I will start the conversation.
- 10. [Student initiates] I am your host parent in Greece. You are very late returning home tonight. You start the conversation.
- 11. [Teacher initiates] I am the head administrator of your school in Greece. One of your teachers sent you to see me. I will start the conversation.
- 12. [Student initiates] I am your Greek friend. While we are at the beach you notice some dark clouds in the sky. You start the conversation.
- **13.** [Student initiates] I am a classmate. Our Greek teacher has been absent for several days. We talk about that. You start the conversation.
- **14.** [Student initiates] I am your waiter in a restaurant in Greece. You notice an error in your bill. You start the conversation.
- 15. [Teacher initiates] I am your friend. You just arrived at school, and I rush over to you to tell you some good news. I will start the conversation.
- **16.** [Student initiates] I am your new neighbor from Greece. You see me standing in front of my house and looking upset. You start the conversation.

- 17. [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek friend. We are at the beach, and it starts to rain. We discuss what we are going to do. I will start the conversation.
- **18.** [Teacher initiates] You are sitting in a crowded sidewalk café in Greece. I am another customer, and I sit down at your table. I will start the conversation.
- 19. [Student initiates] I am your Greek teacher. You need extra time to complete an assignment. You start the conversation.
- **20.** [Student initiates] I have an apartment for rent in *Greece*. Your family is interested in renting it. You call me on the telephone to inquire about it. You start the conversation.
- 21. [Student initiates] I am the new Greek student in your school. You want to get to know me. You start the conversation.
- 22. [Teacher initiates] You are an exchange student in Greece. I am a reporter for a local newspaper. I want to interview you about teenagers in the United States. I will start the conversation.
- 23. [Student initiates] I am your Greek friend. You have lost one of your favorite possessions and you want to talk to me about that. You start the conversation.
- **24.** [Teacher initiates] The Greek club wants to organize an activity to raise some money for a good cause. I am the club advisor. You and I discuss this activity. I will start the conversation.

- **25.** [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek friend. I am in the hospital. You come to visit me. I will start the conversation.
- **26.** [Student initiates] You are traveling on a train in *Greece*. I am a Greek passenger sitting next to you. You start a conversation with me.
- 27. [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek-speaking neighbor. While playing ball with our friends, you accidentally damaged my property. You have come to my door to explain. I will start the conversation.
- **28.** [Student initiates] I am your Greek friend. You complain about the extra work you have been asked to do around the house. **You start the conversation.**
- 29. [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek friend. We are discussing what we will do after graduation. I will start the conversation.
- **30.** [Student initiates] I am your Greek friend. I have a part-time job, and you want know more about it. You start the conversation.
- **31.** [Teacher initiates] I am your host parent in Greece. I notice that you are not eating your meals as you used to do. We will discuss the situation. I will start the conversation.
- **32.** [Student initiates] You are traveling by bus in the United States. I am a Greek tourist and I am having difficulty communicating in English. You offer to help me. **You start the conversation.**

- 33. [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek friend. We were studying together at your house last night. I think I left my notebook at your house. I call you on the telephone. I will start the conversation.
- 34. [Student initiates] I am your host parent in *Greece*. You want to show me pictures of people and places from your home and tell me about them. You start the conversation.
- 35. [Student initiates] I am a Greek-speaking neighbor who likes animals. You ask me for help with an animal you have found. You start the conversation.
- **36.** [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek teacher. You have just returned from your summer vacation. We will talk about it. I will start the conversation.
- **37.** [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek friend. We are going to attend a special event and you do not know what to wear. I will start the conversation.
- **38.** [Student initiates] I am Greek your friend. There is an event at school tonight. I have no way of getting there. We talk about it. You start the conversation.
- **39.** [Student initiates] I am a cyclist in Greece and just had an accident. You come to my aid. You start the conversation.
- **40.** [Student initiates] You are in a park in Greece. I am a young child. I am crying. You try to help. You start the conversation.

- 41. [Student initiates] I am a police officer in *Greece*. You have witnessed something unusual. You have come to me to report it. You start the conversation.
- 42. [Student initiates] You are in Greece and you would like the opportunity to play your favorite sport. I am your host parent. We talk about it. You start the conversation.
- **43.** [Teacher initiates] You are waiting in line to enter a museum in Greece. I am a Greek student standing in front of you. I will start the conversation.
- **44.** [Teacher initiates] I am your friend in Greece. I want to redecorate my room. You help me plan some changes. I will start the conversation. I will start the conversation.
- **45.** [Student initiates] I am your friend. We had planned to go to a concert but we are having a problem finding tickets. **You start the conversation.**
- **46.** [Teacher initiates] You are shopping for winter clothing. I am the Greek storekeeper. I will start the conversation.
- 47. [Teacher initiates] We are campers at the same camp ground. We have just met and we are talking about interesting sights and activities in the area. I will start the conversation.
- **48.** [Student initiates] I am your employer in a Greek restaurant in the United States. You need more days off. We discuss it. **You start the conversation.**

- **49.** [Teacher initiates] I am your friend in Greece. You have accepted an invitation to dinner at my home. At the last minute, you call to say that you are unable to come. I will start the conversation.
- **50.** [Student initiates] You have just arrived in a small Greek village, and you want to know more about it. I am a local resident. You start the conversation.
- **51.** [Student initiates] You have just arrived at the airport in Athens, but the person who was supposed to meet you is not there. I am an airline employee. You come to me for help. You start the conversation.
- **52.** [Student initiates] I am your classmate. You are in charge of a school party next week. You need my help. You start the conversation.
- **53.** [Student initiates] I am your friend. We are visiting a city in *Greece*. There is a magnificent view from a certain place in this city. We discuss whether or not to go there. **You start the conversation.**
- **54.** [Teacher initiates] I am a doctor in a hospital in Greece. You have had a minor accident and have come to the emergency room. We talk about your injury. I will start the conversation.

- 55. [Teacher initiates] I am a talkative taxi driver in *Greece*. You called for a taxi and I have come to pick you up. I will start the conversation.
- **56.** [Student initiates] I am your neighbor. You need to find a dentist and you have come to me for suggestions. You start the conversation.
- 57. [Teacher initiates] I am your Greek friend. I have seen an advertisement for a sale at a local store. I will start the conversation.
- 58. [Student initiates] You are at the airport in *Greece*, ready to board the plan to return home. You hear an announcement that your flight will be delayed. I am the airline representative. You want to talk to me about this situation. You start the conversation.
- **59.** [Teacher initiates] I am the manager of a Greek bank in New York State. I am hiring help for the summer. You are here for an interview for a summer job. I will start the conversation. I will start the conversation.
