Please be advised that student _____ has registered with the **Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America/District Office of Education** to sit for the *2015 Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek*, which is scheduled for administration on **Monday, June 22nd**, from **1:15 p.m. – 4:15 p.m.**

The *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek* is “a locally developed foreign language examination” aligned to the **Checkpoint A & B** learning standards for LOTE (Languages Other Than English) as described in the **Syllabus: Modern Languages for Communication** of the New York State Education Department. The Examination may afford high school students, who pursue studies in the Modern Greek language for more than two years, the opportunity to earn a Regents diploma with advanced designation (NYCRR §100.5[b][7][v][c]). Awarding of credits for foreign language studies, however, is at the discretion of the public or private school principal.

To be eligible for the *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek*, students must be in the eighth grade or above. Kindly verify below the class **grade** of the above named student.
