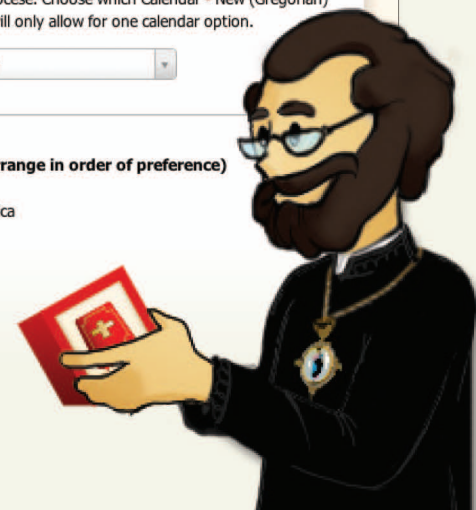
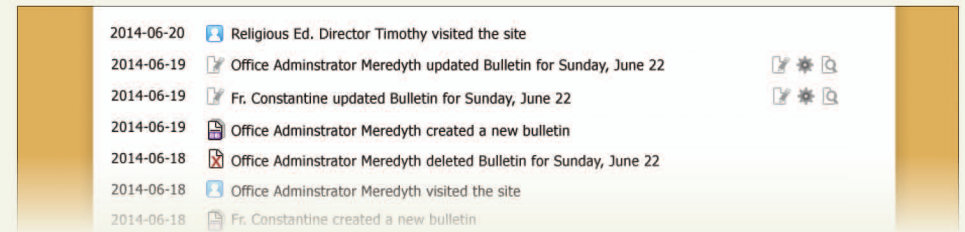

The Lord, when choosing His twelve disciples, chose from an undistinguished and inconspicuous group of men and women. The Apostles were mostly fishermen. The women who followed him and who hearkened to His every word had no royal blood or prominent careers. They, men and women, were regular people, responsible, eager to learn, happy to receive good news, who had a deep and burning faith in Jesus Christ. They also were faithful and lived in empowering hope.

The Lord didn't choose from the elites, probably because they would be susceptible to pride that would not allow them to follow an average, nondescript man who came without credentials or pedigree. And yet these men and women were charged with proclaiming a new kingdom of love, forgiveness, and mercy and were instructed to love their neighbor as themselves. They were not provided with weapons of destruction. *How often were they tormented with needs of transportation or provisions of food and...*
