



#### Insights into modern Cancer Care:

- At that time a large crowd followed and pressed around him. And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years.



#### Cancer Services:

- 1991 Cervical Cancer
- 1993 Breast Cancer
- 1994 The Center becomes a member of the European Networks of Centers of Excellence in both Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening
- 2002 BRCA1 & 2 assessment begins
- 2005 Skin Cancer
- 2006 Colon Cancer (being planned)









# The special insight our people give the Ormylia Center:

- The majority of are village dwellers (most villages are under 2,000 persons)
- 85% are farmers
- 55% have only a primary school education
- 35% are formally uneducated
- 10% make up high school grads and higher learning, or technical training
- 9% are immigrants from the Former Soviet Union and Albania


#### Some useful data:

- The Ormylia Patient base: 25,000 + women
- 150,000 + Screening Examinations
- 7,000 women screened annually (all services rendered without payment)
- Some women in their 9th round of Screening
- 20-25 breast cancers annually (most Stage 1 and under)
- 5-10 cervical cancers annually
- 5-7 HPV's annually

#### The foundation for new developments:

- 92% patient return rate (we do not lose the patients that come to be screened!)
- 95%> five year survival rate for positive patients
- 150 fields of epidemiological data collected on each patient
- Very personal relationship with all the persons screened and their families



- "Regular" folk




#### Communication based on love and sincerity:
