## RECOMMENDED SALARY SCALE

## 1) FOR PAROCHIAL DAY SCHOOL TEACHERS SERVING FULL-TIME

**B.A./B.S. Degree** 

M.A./M.S. Degree and/or Experience

Average Salary \$28,000 – \$30,000

Starting at \$30,000

- The above salary range is intended for teachers with university, or college degrees obtained in the U.S.A. and/or from Greece.
- Salaries must be commensurate with professional qualifications and previous experience and should be adjusted every year according to the cost of living.
- Salaries of teachers serving for more than **10** years in the Archdiocesan Parochial School System not necessarily in a particular school should appropriately be adjusted.
- Health Insurance coverage is strongly recommended for teachers working full-time.

## 2) FOR GREEK-AFTERNOON SCHOOL TEACHERS

- Teachers serving in the afternoon Greek schools must be compensated with a minimum of \$35 \$50 per teaching hour, depending on his/her qualifications and previous professional experience.
- The annual salary must be calculated by multiplying the weekly salary by <u>40</u>, which reflects the duration of a standard school year. Thus, serving for **five days a week** (two teaching hours per day), a teacher may earn a minimum of **\$14,000 \$20,000**.
- For those teachers employed **four days** per week adjustments are made at **4**/5 of the recommended salary; for **three days** at **3**/5, and so forth. For example, a teacher working **two days** per week shall be paid a minimum of **\$5,600 \$8,000** annually.
- Teachers shall receive additional compensation for the extra time they spent in participating in various school events that take place off-school hours as well as for travel expenses to and from school (gas and tolls) if their travel to school requires using their own car.
