Commuters

For those wishing to attend the full conference, but do not need housing, please submit one of the Registration Fees and the Required Fee for meals and materials.

Housing

There are two housing options:

Polemanakos Dormitory

A limited number of rooms are available on a first-come, first-serve basis in Polemanakos Dormitory. Guests **MUST** arrive no later than 3:30 pm Thursday afternoon (July 30) as there is no staff available after-hours to grant them access to their rooms: guests who arrive late will not be able to check-in and will have to find alternative accommodations on their own; a fee for one night's stay (\$25) will be charged. Please note that Polemanakos rooms are single rooms, no private baths. There are no rooms for couples or children. The dorm is not air conditioned.

Hilton Dedham

Rooms have been reserved at the Hilton Dedham (25 Allied Drive, Dedham, Massachusetts, United States 02026-6147; Tel: 1-781-329-7900, Fax: 1-781-329-5552). A discounted rate of \$109 per night is available to guests who make their reservations prior to June 30 and ask for the **GOA Summer Institute**. We will operate a shuttle between the campus and the hotel during the Institute. We recommend that you try to arrive Thursday by noon on campus.

Transportation

By Air: Fly to Boston Logan International Airport (BOS). A taxi from the airport to the campus will cost approx. \$40 and take about 30 minutes or so, depending on traffic and time of day. A taxi to the hotel will cost about \$65.

Public Transportation (the MBTA, or the "T") from the airport to the Brookline Area. From your terminal take the MBTA bus to the Airport Station on the Blue Line. Take the Blue Line inbound to Boston.

Transfer at the State Street Station to the Orange Line to Forest Hills, getting off the train at Forest Hills Station (the end of the line). This will cost \$2 and take about 40 minutes. There are almost always taxis at this station, about \$8-10 to the campus.

Or, you can take the Blue Line to Government Center. Transfer to the Green Line D train, getting off the train at Brookline Village. This too will cost \$2. The Green line is a little slower and finding a taxi at Brookline Village is a little harder, but the cost is also about \$8-10.

By Train: Along the Northeast Corridor, Amtrak runs to Westwood/Rte 128 outside Boston, which places you in the vicinity of the hotel. Or, take Amtrak to Boston's Back Bay Station. From there you can either take the Orange Line to Forest Hills (the Back Bay Station is also an Orange Line stop) and follow the above information. Or you can take a taxi to the campus, about \$15-20. If you need guidance on reaching the campus from either Boston's South Station or North Station, please contact the Department.
