

THE COMPREHENSIVE EXAMINATION IN MODERN GREEK
MONDAY, JUNE 23, 2014 (9:15 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.)

The Direct Archdiocesan District Office of Education is pleased to announce that the **2014 Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek** will be administered on **Monday, June 23rd**, from **9:15 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.**

The *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek* is “a locally developed foreign language examination,” aligned to the *Checkpoint B* learning standards for Languages Other Than English (LOTE) as described in the *Syllabus: Modern Languages for Communication* of the New York State Education Department.

To qualify for the *Examination*, students must be in the eighth grade or higher and have successfully completed at least **three years** of studies in the Modern Greek language.

The *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek* may afford high school students who pursue studies in Modern Greek for more than two years the opportunity to earn a Regents diploma with advanced designation CR 100.5(b) (7). However, awarding credits for foreign language studies is at the discretion of the local public or private school principal.
