

THE COMPREHENSIVE EXAMINATION IN MODERN GREEK
MONDAY, JUNE 22, 2015 (1:15 a.m. – 4:15 p.m.)

The Direct Archdiocesan District Office of Education is pleased to announce that the **2015 Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek** will be administered on **Monday, June 22nd**, from **1:15 p.m.** to **4:15 p.m.**

The *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek* is “a locally developed foreign language examination,” aligned to the *Checkpoint B* learning standards for Languages Other Than English (LOTE) as described in the *Syllabus: Modern Languages for Communication* of the New York State Education Department.

The *Examination* assesses the student’s language skills in speaking, listening, reading, and writing the Modern Greek language. To qualify for the *Examination*, students must be in the eighth grade or higher and have successfully completed **three years** of studies in the Modern Greek language.

The *Comprehensive Examination in Modern Greek* may afford high school students, who pursue studies in the Modern Greek language for more than two years, the opportunity to earn a Regents diploma with advanced designation (NYCRR §100.5[b][7][v][c]). However, awarding of credits for foreign language studies is at the discretion of the public or private school principal.
