

MODEL STRUCTURE FOR SESSION WITH BREAKOUT ROOMS (FOR YOUTH WORKERS)

12:00PM: WELCOME

- Staff member 1: Welcomes each participant as they enter Zoom
- Staff member 2: Monitoring the group
- Staff member 3: Working on Break out groups

12:10PM ICEBREAKER

- Staff member 4: Explains the ice breaker

12:19PM PRAYER

- Clergy 1: Offers the prayer

12:20PM INTRO

- Staff member 1: Introduces the Clergy/Staff member who will teach the lesson

12:25PM SESSION

- Clergy 1 or Staff Leader 1: Teaches the lesson
 - Simple message
 - Clear Goal and Objective
 - Finishes with 3 simple questions for Breakout group leaders
 - Gives these questions to Staff before the Session

12:45PM SMALL GROUP BREAKOUTS

- Staff Member 3 - Automates breakout groups
 - Participants and staff will automatically be put in to small groups
 - Participants and staff will automatically be put back into the main group

- Keep groups the same each time to help facilitate discussion
